Protecting Innocent Children from Violence
Speech For Legislative Pro-Life Rally
West Capitol Steps
28 February 2018

Thank you all for giving all of us legislators the opportunity to defend and promote pro-life legislation. Pro-life candidates cannot become pro-life elected officials without the steady and unwavering assistance of pro-life supporters like you. So thank you for standing together.

These are **challenging times**. Our news is full of horrible violence against innocent children in public schools. The anger and volume of parents, residents, and opportunistic special interest groups consume our phone lines, our emails, and our encounters.

In the midst of all this, is **an agenda** to remove the ability for families to defend themselves with firearms. But the noise about “gun” violence is screaming louder than ever. And the focus on a “safe environment for our children in schools” is on everyone’s front page.

What is being drowned out is the simple concept of protecting innocent children from violence.

And this is no accident. Because the care we as humans have for our most vulnerable is written on our hearts. We instantly rush to the aid of the innocent unjustly victimized by violence – most especially violence that results in death.

So most telling will be the deliberate and difficult juxtaposition our emotional legislators will have in the next few hours when **the same House Committee** that heard 9 hours of heart-wrenching testimony just last week of the violence against our innocent school children, will

now turn into cold heartedness toward the extreme violence of dismemberment abortions of unborn babies and the harvesting and trafficking of their now valuable human parts.

The same people who cry that unborn children are not humans at all, seek to harvest their organs and serve them right up to the laboratories of our universities so medical professionals can use them just like Hitler's Germany and Communist China.

At 1:30pm today, two more proposed bills aimed at protecting the cruel and barbaric ritual of mutilating tiny humans for the convenience and profit of others, will be heard by **the same people** who last week cried out for an end to child violence.

If you did not think that Truth must be twisted to advance Evil, then you will need to hear the questions, speeches, and voting of 6 of the 9 members of the Committee hearing our bills. The **wicked irony** of pontificating to end child violence one week only to condone and promote it again the next, is too painful to reason.

Today, I will be presenting my bill to terminate taxpayer funding to any state institution which engages in the harvesting, trafficking, purchasing, or selling of aborted baby body parts, whether directly or indirectly.

You would think that in a civilized society, there would be no need to legislate against **human sacrifice**. But here we are, trying to convince elected officials not to allow our state universities to pluck out eyeballs, hearts, and kidneys of aborted babies so we can worship at the altar of Science to service the needs of our lives at the expense of those who cannot prevent our aggression.

We have come a long way in our culture. It will do us well to keep track of our moral compass so we can see how far we have come **lest we lose our way**. I think of Lot in the city of Sodom when all the people of two cities were so possessed with evil and abhorrent behavior. How did he and his family ever stay focused on Truth?

We must never be discouraged by the immorality that takes place around us. We will be held accountable for our own thoughts and actions. Just like Jonah, we can weather the storm and become bold in our message to promote the Culture of Life no matter what the resistance.

Stay the course. Fight the Fight. Our goal is not Success, but in being **Faithful**.
